This user guide provides a simple introduction to navigating and using the ArcGIS Enterprise web map developed by OTRD for the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) Projects in Oklahoma. Through this interactive mapping application, users can view 6(f)(3) boundaries and explore associated data, including project numbers and sponsors.

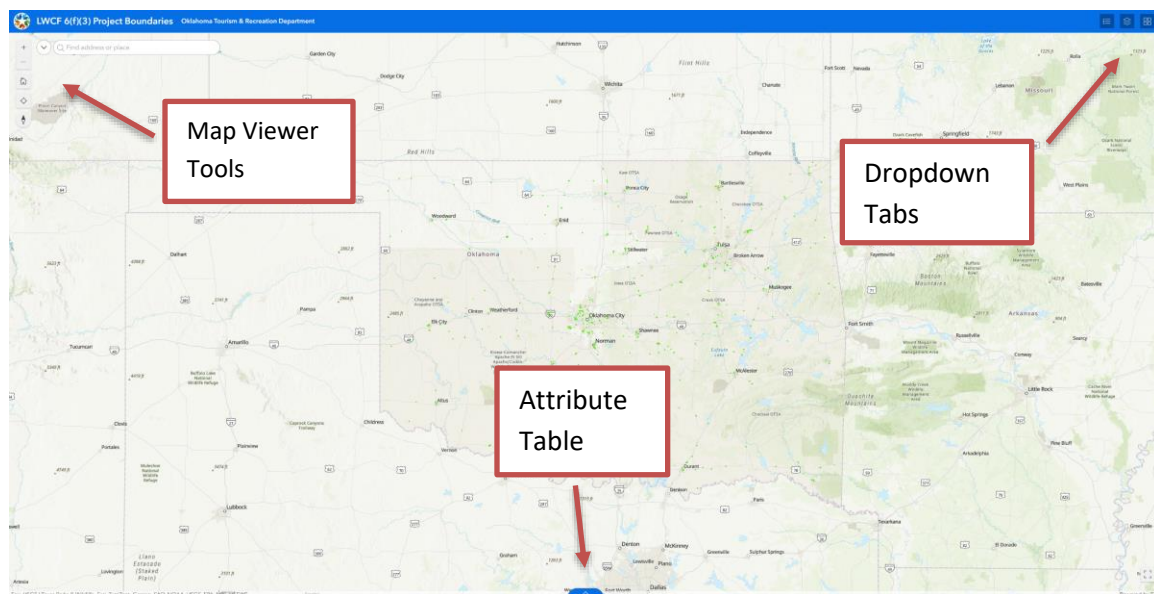
Tips for First-Time Users

- Use a desktop computer for the best viewing experience (preferably using Chrome or Edge)
- Refresh the browser if the map doesn't load correctly

Understanding the Layout

Our ArcGIS Experience application features:

- Map Viewer: The interactive area for exploring locations and features
- Side Panel or Tabs: Where you'll find information, filters, search tools, and legend
- Attribute Table: The tabular data assigned to each geospatial feature (project boundary, trail, etc.)



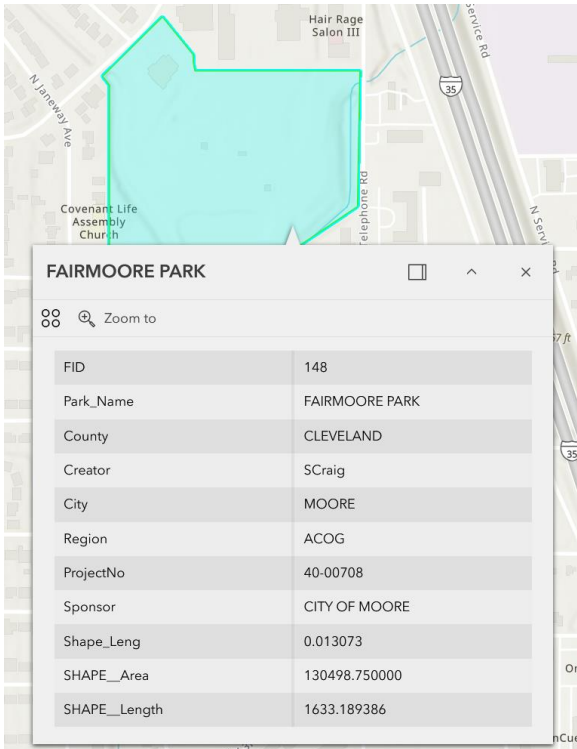

Click on any geospatial feature to see more information.

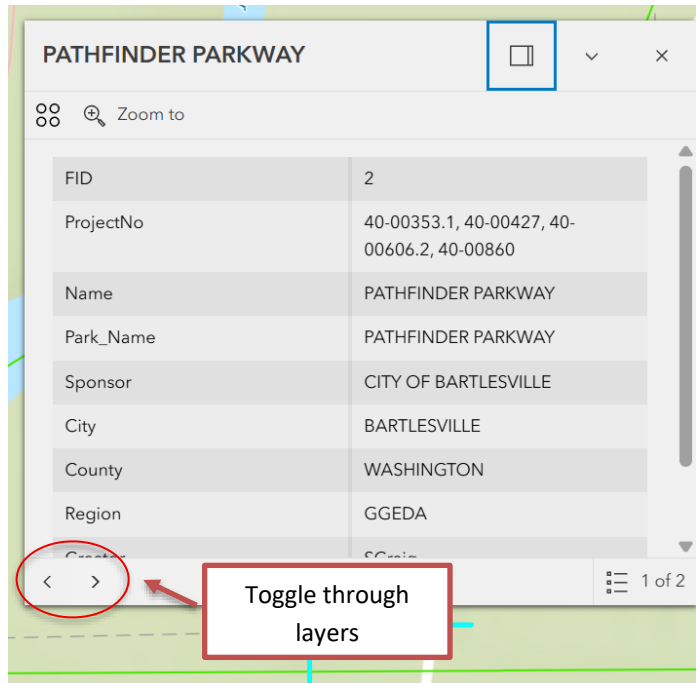
- A pop-up will appear with location details.

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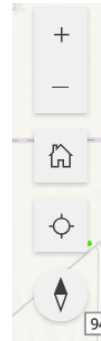

Navigating the Map

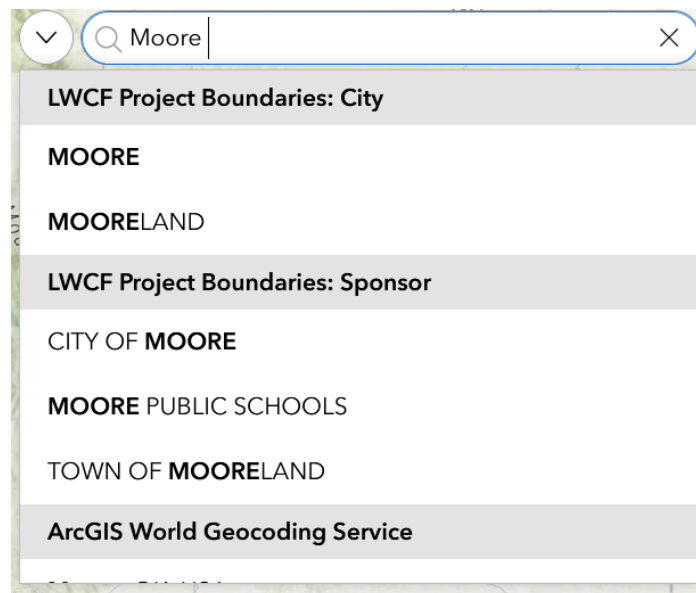
- Zoom In/Out: Use + and – icons or your mouse scroll wheel
- Reset View: Click the  Home icon to return to the original map view
- Locate: Click the  Locate icon to center the map on your location
- Compass: Click the  Compass icon to orient the map in a North-South direction



Using Map Tools

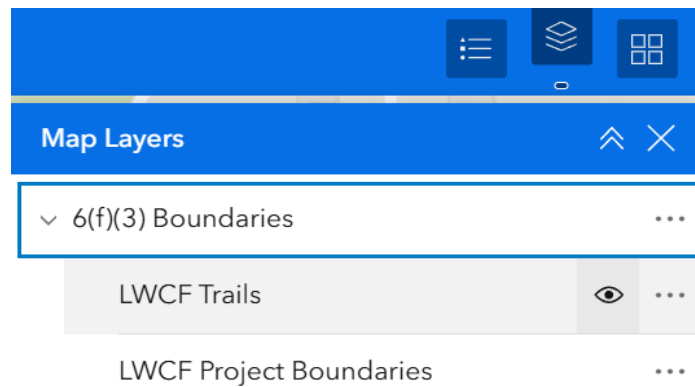
The following tools can be utilized to customize your viewing experience:

Search Bar – Search features and locations by City, County, COG, Project Number, or Sponsor

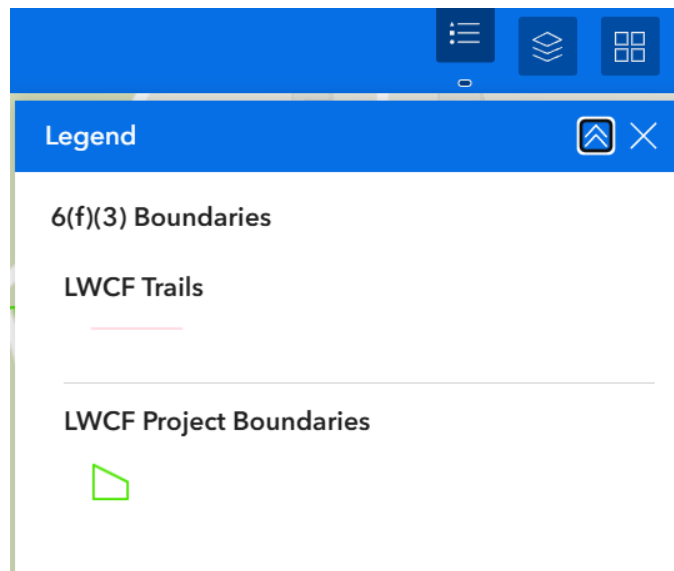




Layer List – Toggle map layers on or off

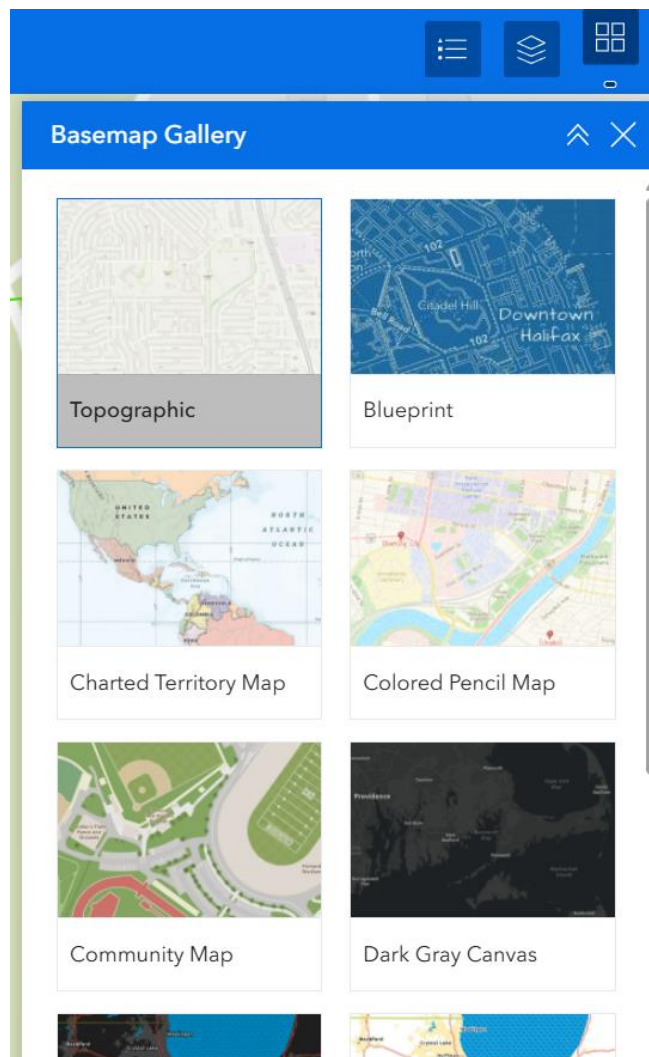


Legend – Learn what symbols/colors represent
